Classic

M/W16(not championship), M/W20, M/W21, M/W35, M/W40, M/W45, M/W50, M/W55, M/W60 M/W65, M/W70

Competition sequence: Location orienteering – Orienteering – Shooting – Finish

Sprint

M/W16(not championship), M/W20, M/W21, M/W35, M/W40, M/W45, M/W50, M/W55, M/W60 M/W65, M/W70

Competition sequence: Orienteering – Prone shooting – Orienteering – Standing shooting – Finish

Relay

M/W16(not championship), M/W20, M/W21, M/W70, M/W95, M/W120, Mix(not championship)

Competition sequence: Orienteering – Prone shooting – Orienteering – Standing shooting – Changeover / Finish

All teams consist of two participants except M21-teams which consists of three.

Master-teams: Total age (based on year of birth) of team participants, all participants must be born 1983 or earlier.

Mix-teams: two participants, no restriction of age or nationality.

Classic competition are held at Race Arena Tvorup.

Sprint and Relay competitions are held at Race Arena Finderup.

Length of courses, difficulty and penalty loops are according to IBOF's rules.

Rules

Target

Self-marking target system

Weapon & ammunition

.22 long rifle (calibre 5.6 mm). Every participant bring their own weapon and Ammunition. All participants have to pass the weapon inspection every day of competition.



Control system

Emit. All EMIT cards are given by organiser. Same card for all competitions. Emit card will be handed out in the startingpoint at the first competition.

Map & terrain

Tvorup, scale 1:10.000 for all classes, equidistance 2,5 m, map from 2016/2017

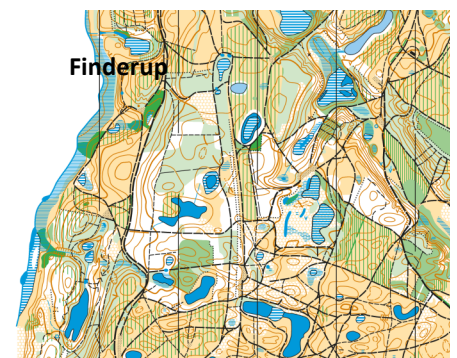
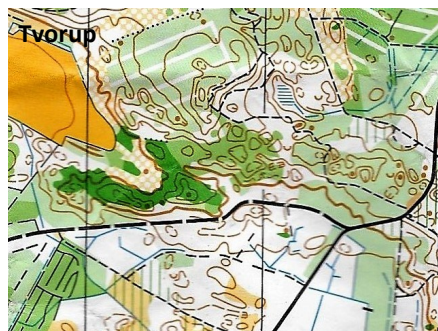
The forest is characterized by larger flat areas with some ditches. The flat areas are interrupted by stripes of hilly dunes with pines. Generally there is a lot of paths and roads but some areas have almost no paths.

The vegetation is pines varied from small parts with dense forest to an open forest with old trees. In some areas all the trees have been felled and other areas are dunes without trees. Generally good runability.

Finderup, Scale 1:10.000 for all classes, equidistance 2.5 m, map from 2017

The area offers a magnificent glacial landscape with many interesting, unique and varying orientation challenges. The landscape is sculpted by the intense pressure of the ice masses and the erosion of the meltwater during the last Ice Age. Together these have created distinctive tunnel valleys, lakes, dead-ice kettles in a terrain with hilly slopes and nutrient-poor heathland on sandy sediment.

The forest consists mainly of conifers. In the eastern part of the area is a typical central Jutland plantation with a detailed curve image and rapid changing visibility and run ability created by either fallen trees from hurricanes or from intense forestry. Some areas are with many paths and trails, but also large areas without proper lead lines. The western parts of the area is used as military training ground and have open heather and grassy areas but also areas with open sand created by tracked vehicles. The dead-ice kettles appear either as deep lakes or marshes.
